Autumn 1– Journeys

Pupils can choose genre from diary form, letter, 1st person, narrative or poetry. The writing will be based upon their learning about the journeys children face as a consequence of war.

Autumn 2– Christmas 2119

Let your imagination run wild—what might Christmas be like in 100 years' time? Where might humans celebrate it? What might have changed? What might people have kept the same? This piece of science fiction could be a short story, letter or in diary form.

Spring 1– A Call to Action

Pupils can create a poster or flyer (in groups or pairs) as we enter a new decade and we think about New Year Resolutions. What are the BIG issues you want to raise awareness of? Who is your target audience?

Spring 2 –Read All About It!

A non-fiction newspaper report linked to “events” in class core text or about things we have done in school this year so far– as part of our mid-year review– each year will produce their own year group newspaper.

Summer 1– Showtime

A small group creation of short play scripts (single act play) linked to their topic within Foundation learning.

Summer 2–Changes

Reflecting on transition and time moving on, pupils can write a autobiographical/narrative piece of writing about something that has changed them, how places change or how their/ others' thinking /feelings change.
